Supporting Your Child After School

Throughout the school day, children experience many transitions and receive a variety of directions from teachers and staff. These constant shifts can be mentally and emotionally demanding. At home, it's important to provide time for your child to settle down, rest, and recharge. A calm transition allows their minds to process the day, restore focus, and be ready to enjoy the rest of their evening in a healthy, balanced way.

Helpful Tips: Talking With Your Child About Their Day

For TK-5th Graders:

1. Ask about a favorite moment: "What was the best thing that happened today?"
2. Spark details through play: "Can you show me how you played at recess?"
3. Focus on feelings: "What made you feel proud (or happy) today?"
4. Encourage storytelling: "If you could give your day a title, what would it be?"

For 6th-8th Graders:

1. Ask about highlights: "What was something interesting you learned today?"
2. Encourage reflection: "What was the hardest part of your day, and how did you handle it?"
3. Invite connection: "Who did you hang out with today, and what did you talk about?"
4. Empower voice: "If you could change one thing about your school day, what would it be?"
